

Village of Port Elgin Notice of Intention To Amend the Municipal Plan



PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Village of Port Elgin intends to consider a proposed By-law to amend By-law No. 01-42, the “Village of Port Elgin Municipal Plan”.

The proposed By-law is intended to redesignate a portion of the property known as PID #00791400, located at 55 West Main Street from Rural Residential & Residential to Institutional for the purpose of developing a new ambulance building.

The proposed By-law also proposes to redesignate the property known as PID 70105275, located at 53 West Main Street from Institutional to Residential on the Future Land Use Map for the purpose of permitting residential in the former ambulance building.

Any person wishing to inspect the proposed By-law may do so at the Village Office 9 East Main Street, Port Elgin, NB during regular office hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday except holidays or on the Southeast Regional Service Commission, Plan 360 website:
